What is APEL?

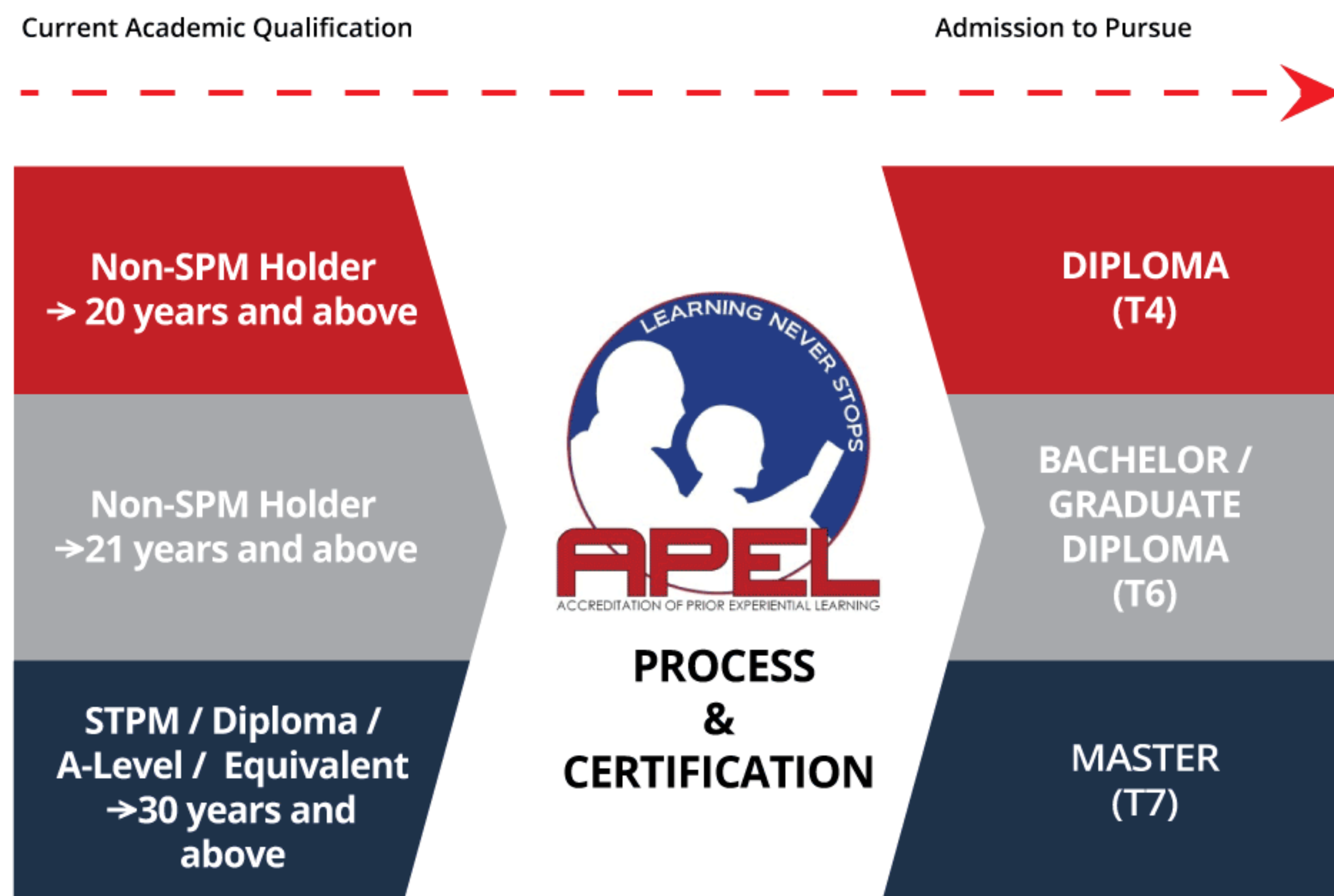
Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL) provides an opportunity for individuals with working experience but lack of formal academic qualifications to pursue studies at Higher Education Institutions. In general, knowledge obtained through both formal education and work experience is assessed.

APEL involves the identification, documentation and assesment of prior experiential learning to determine the extent to which an individual has achieved the desired learning outcomes, for access to a programme of study and/or award of credits.

There are two types of APEL :

- APEL for Admission (APEL (A))
- APEL for Credit Award (APEL (C))

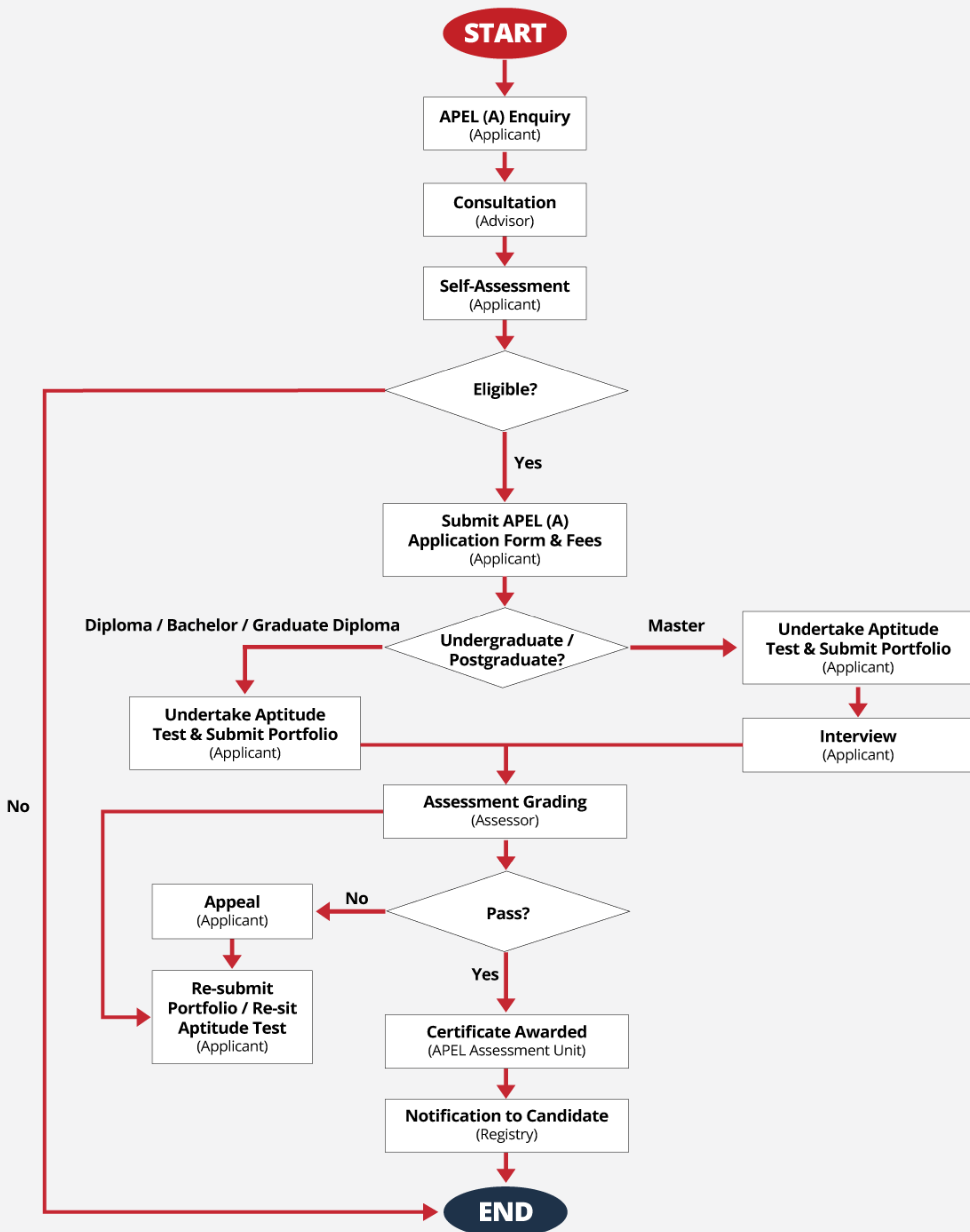

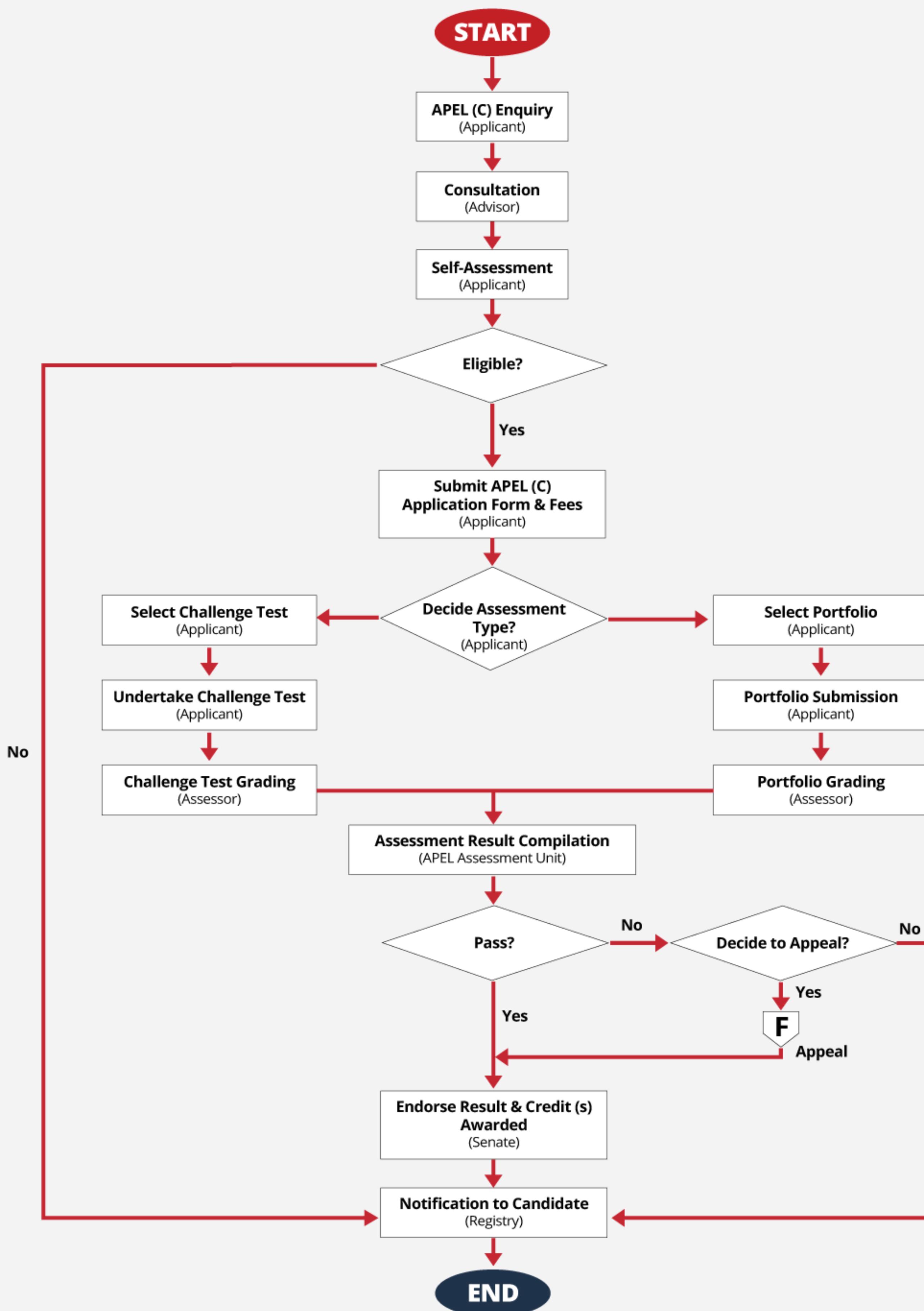
