Asia e University (AeU) is pleased to announce the appointment of Emeritus Professor Tan Sri Datuk Dr Nik Mustapha bin Raja Abdullah as the Vice-Chancellor effective 1st March 2021. Emeritus Professor Dr Nik Mustapha succeeds Emeritus Professor Dato' Dr Hassan Said who has been the Vice-Chancellor from March 2019 to February 2021.

Born in Machang, Kelantan on December 26, 1954, Emeritus Professor Dr Nik Mustapha first obtained his Diploma in Agriculture from Universiti Putra Malaysia in 1976, followed by his Bachelors in Resource Economics in 1979 from the University of California at Davis.

Subsequently Emeritus Professor Dr. Nik Mustapha completed his Master (1980) and PhD (1988) in Agriculture and Resource Economics from Oregon State University.

Emeritus Professor Dr. Nik Mustapha is a Fisheries and Recreational Economist with three decades of experience. He joined Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) as a lecturer in 1981 and was promoted to an Associate Professor in 1993 and as a Professor four years later in 1997. Throughout his tenure in UPM, Emeritus Professor Dr. Nik Mustapha was appointed in several key positions including Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Management (1999-2004), Deputy Vice Chancellor (June 2004-31st December 2005), and Vice Chancellor of UPM (2006-2010).

His expertise is acknowledged by the industries as he has been a dedicated member in 41 organizations as corporate boards, fellowships and committee such as Chairman Putra Business School, Board of Directors UPM, the Institute of Marketing Malaysia (IMM) and Deputy President of the Federation of Universities in Islamic World (2008-2010).

He was conferred the Emeritus Professor by University Putra Malaysia (UPM) on 16 November 2019 and is currently a Pro-Chancellor II, at City University Malaysia.

During 30 years of his career, Emeritus Professor Dr. Nik Mustapha has 170 publications which includes journal articles, book chapters and technical reports, staff papers and also research and consultancy reports.
