ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

MALAYSIAN

The minimum entry requirements are as follows:

- STPM / A-Level or any equivalent qualifications with minimum Grade C (CGPA 2.0) in two (2) subjects AND pass in Mathematic and English Language at SPM / O-Level or equivalent; OR
- STAM with minimum Grade Jayyid AND Pass in Mathematic and English Language at SPM / O-Level or any equivalent qualifications; OR
- A Diploma / Advanced Diploma OR any equivalent qualifications; OR
- A Matriculation / Foundation Programme or any equivalent qualifications with minimum CGPA of 2.00; OR
- UEC with minimum Grade B in five (5) subjects AND Pass in Mathematic and English Language; OR
- Other recognised equivalent qualifications

INTERNATIONAL

The minimum entry requirements are as follows:

- A-Level or any equivalent qualifications with minimum Grade C (CGPA 2.0) in two (2) subjects AND pass in Mathematic and English Language at O-Level or any equivalent qualifications; OR
- Pass in Mathematic and English Language at O-Level or any equivalent qualifications; OR

- A Diploma / Advanced Diploma OR any equivalent qualifications; OR
- A Foundation Programme or equivalent qualifications with a minimum CGPA of 2.00; OR
- Other recognised equivalent qualifications.

Minimum English Language Requirements for

- Achieve a minimum Band 3 in Malaysian University English Test (MUET) OR equivalent to Common European Framework.

Note: If a student does not meet this requirement, AeU will offer English proficiency courses to ensure that the student's proficiency is sufficient to meet the needs of the programme.
