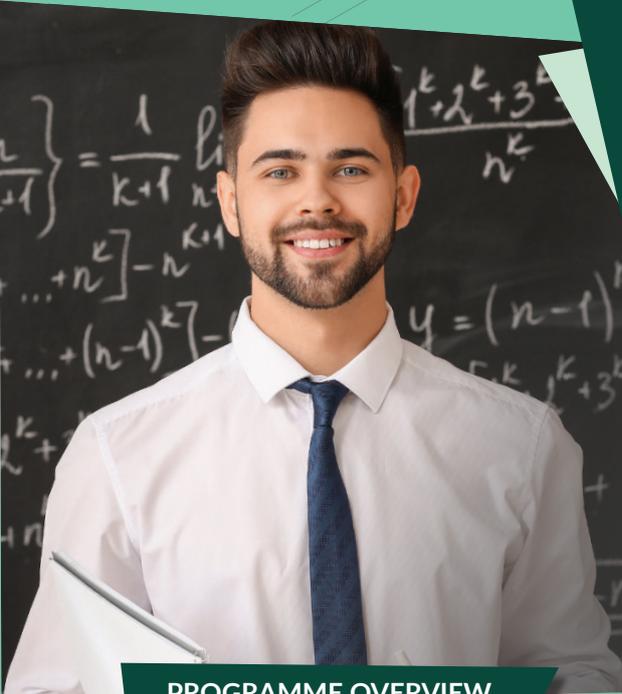

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

MALAYSIAN

The minimum entry requirements are as follows:

- A recognised Bachelor's Degree or equivalent with CGPA minimum 2.50; OR
- A recognised Bachelor's Degree or equivalent qualifications with CGPA below 2.50 with a minimum five (5) years working experience in related fields.

INTERNATIONAL

The minimum entry requirements are as follows:

- A recognised Bachelor's Degree or equivalent with CGPA minimum 2.50; OR
- A recognised Bachelor's Degree or equivalent qualifications with CGPA below 2.50 with a minimum five (5) years working experience in related fields.

Minimum English Language Requirements for International Students:

- Minimum score of 5.0 for IELTS; OR
- Minimum score for TOEFL PBT 410-433 / TOEFL 34-40; OR

- Pearson Test of English PTE 36; OR
- Cambridge English: Advance (CAE) 160; OR
- Cambridge English: Proficiency (CPE) 180; OR
- Malaysian University English Test (MUET Band 3)

Those who have their tertiary education in English will normally be exempted from the above requirement.

Note: If a student does not meet this requirement, AeU will offer English proficiency courses to ensure that the student's proficiency is sufficient to meet the needs of the programme.
