

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For Malaysian and International Students:

Regular Entry

- A Bachelor's degree in business-related fields with a CGPA of 2.75 or equivalent qualification
- A Bachelor's degree in business-related fields (with a CGPA of 2.5 can be accepted, subject to a strict internal assessment process (may include tests, interviews or portfolio); OR
- A Bachelor's degree in business-related fields but did not reach CGPA 2.5 can be accepted, subject to a minimum five (5) years working experience in related fields
- A research intent is required at the point of entry

Minimum English Language Requirements for International Students:

- Minimum score of 6.0 for IELTS; OR
- Other recognised equivalent test
- Those who have their tertiary education in English will normally be exempted from the above requirement

HOW TO APPLY

STEP 1

Explore the research interests of the Schools to find out what projects or research areas are available

STEP 2

Submit a completed application form for postgraduate research study online. http://myaeu.aeu.edu.my/student_signup.jsp

STEP 3

Other submissions to complete the application

a. Required items for all applicants:

- 1 certified true copy of Identity Card (A4 size, front and back on 1 page / Passport (A4) size)
- 1 set of certified true copy of highest entry academic certificates and transcript
- Two recent passport size colour photograph, with name written on reverse
- A recent portrait colour photo (size of a minimum 1 MB or 1000 KB or more)
- Research intent
- CV or Resume in English

b. For international applicants only:

- Four photocopies of passport (A4 size), all pages including blank pages
- Eight passport size photograph (3.5cm x 5.0cm) with light blue background and name written on reverse
- Certified true copy of academic certificates and transcripts (if academic records in language other than English, it must be accompanied with approved translation)
- Certification letter on completion of studies from previous institutions, if applicant is still waiting for final results
- Certified copy of TOEFL, IELTS or Intensive English programme certificate (if any)
- A recent portrait colour photo (size of a minimum 1 MB or 1000 KB or more)
- Research intent
- CV or Resume in English

The international applicant is advised to submit these documents:

- If not in Malaysia – 2 months before the new semester begins
- If in Malaysia – 1 month before the new semester begins

This research based thesis may take up to 2 years, but students must be committed to complete the programme within stipulated time without penalty

Be effective in time management

Students need to prioritise and manage tasks effectively to ensure completion of one task before moving on to the next. Goal-focus and consistency are essential to achieving commitment-success

Adapt to challenges

Invariably, students may face obstacles and challenges in completing their research, but they must be flexible and resolute to overcome difficulties immediately

Communicate effectively

To earn recognition as a serious master student and a researcher, students must be confident in delivering the Research Proposal Defense, Viva Voce and completed thesis on time and effectively
