From a total of 10 doctoral graduates, five obtained PhD in Education, four PhD in Business Administration and one had a doctorate in Business Administration. One of AeU's distinguished graduates was Datuk Yong Teck Shing from Sabah who graduated with a Masters degree in Science (Management).

Having experienced the extensive research, coupled with a burning desire to achieve the highest academic degree possible, he braved himself in enrolling into the PhD programme in Business Administration at AeU.
