



**AeU's eighth convocation witnessed the graduation of 2,662 students.**

## Commemoration of excellence

A total of 2,662 students recently received their graduation scrolls at Asia e University's (AeU) eighth convocation ceremony. The recipients comprised 2,086 (78%) Malaysian students and 576 (22%) from Canada, Egypt, Ghana, Myanmar, India, Indonesia, Mauritius, the Philippines, Somalia, Sri Lanka and Vietnam.

Of the total, 815 (31%) completed their postgraduate studies and 1,847 (69%), undergraduate programmes. 18 graduated from AeU's doctoral degree programmes: nine obtained PhD in Business Administration, three in Education and two in ICT, while four received the Doctor of Business Administration (DBA). Five international students received their doctorates.

AeU also presented prestigious awards to the five most outstanding graduates:

- ▶ Vincent Dairiam (MBA) achieved the Chairman's Award and Mahani Zainal Award;
- ▶ Leh Siong Lu (Master of Education) obtained the Chairman's Award and School Award;
- ▶ Lee Chiu Yuan (Graduate Diploma in Early Childhood Education) attained the President's Award and School Award;
- ▶ Adieb Hilmi Widigdo (Bachelor of Information and Communication Technology) achieved the President's Award and School Award; and
- ▶ Rohani Su [Bachelor of Education (Teaching Islamic Studies in Primary School)] obtained the President's Award.

At the graduation ceremony, AeU president and CEO Prof Datuk Dr Ansary Ahmed shared a message with the graduates. He said, "Be proud of your qualifications and fly the AeU flag well wherever you're practising, and make a positive impact on the community you are in."
