

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Regular entry requirements

- A pass in Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) / Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia Vokasional (SPMV) with a minimum Credit (Grade C) in five (5) subjects; OR
- A pass in IGCSE/O-Level with a minimum Grade C in five (5) subjects; OR
- A pass in UEC with a minimum Credit Grade B in three (3) subjects ; OR
- Other equivalent qualifications recognised.

Specific entry requirements to University of London (UoL)

- Normally be aged 17 or above before 31 December in the year of registration.
- You must demonstrate fluency in academic English by passing IGCSE/ O-Level English language at grade C or above, or the equivalent, OR
- Have passed a test of proficiency in English, such as IELTS at 5.5 overall (with a minimum of 5.0 in each sub-test).

Normally, you apply online via our course pages:

Submitting documents / evidence

When you apply, you can upload the supporting documents as follows:

- Certified true copy of Identity Card (A4 size, front and back on 1 page) / Passport (A4 size, all pages including blank pages) - minimum 2 years validity period;
- Recent passport size photo with white background;
- Certified true copies of academic certificates and transcripts (If academic records are in language other than English, it must be accompanied with approved translation.);
- Certified true copies of TOEFL, IELTS or intensive English programme certificate (mainly for international applicant);
- Completed health declaration form (mainly for international applicant);
- Certified true copies of award letter for scholarship/sponsorship (if any).

STUDENT PASS / VISA APPLICATION

(For International Students)

It is mandatory for international applicant to hold a student pass in order to study in Malaysia. The Student & Alumni Affairs (SAA) will assist you. Applicants are advised to apply two (2) months ahead of their desired intake to allow for processing time. - practise soft skills such as leadership, entrepreneurial and team skills effectively and, apply and manage real-life situations and challenges.


