## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

### MALAYSIAN

The minimum entry requirements are as follows:

- A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) or its equivalent with a minimum Grade C+ (GP 2.33) in any two subjects, and credits in Mathematics and a pass in English at Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) level; OR
- A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a minimum grade of Jayyid, (good) and credits in Mathematics and a pass in English at SPM level; OR
- A Diploma in Accounting (Level 4 MQF) or related field, or its equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.50, and credits in Mathematics and a pass in English at SPM Level; OR
- Matriculation/ Foundation qualification or its equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.50, and credits in Mathematics and a pass in English at SPM level; OR
- Other equivalent qualifications recognized by the AeU Senate; AND
- Malaysian University English Test (MUET) Band 2

### INTERNATIONAL

The minimum entry requirements are as follows:

- A diploma in accounting or related field, or its equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.50; OR
- Matriculation/Foundation qualification or its equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.50; OR
- Other equivalent qualifications recognized by the AeU Senate;

#### Minimum English Language Requirements

- TOEFL score of 550 OR IELTS score of 5.5 OR its equivalent.
- Malaysian University English Test (MUET) Band 2

*Note: If a student does not meet this requirement, AeU will offer English proficiency courses to ensure that the student's proficiency is sufficient to meet the needs of the programme.*
